On the approval of the Action Plan for Intellectual Property Rights  
Enforcement in the Republic of Moldova

In order to strengthen the protection and enforcement of intellectual property rights in the Republic of Moldova, to intensify cooperation between public authorities in the relevant field, and pursuant to the provisions of Article 10 of Law No 114/2014 on the State Agency on Intellectual Property, Article 13 paragraph (4) of Law No 320/2012 on Police Activity and the Status of the Police officer, Article 8 point m) of Law No 302/2017 on Customs Service, Article 34 paragraph (1) of Law No 183/2012 on Competition, point 10 subpoint 1) of the Regulation on the organization and functioning of the State Inspectorate for Supervision of Non-Food Products and Consumer Protection, approved by Government Decision No 466/2022, point 8 subpoint 9) of the Regulation on the organization and functioning of the National Agency for Food Safety, approved by Government Decision No 14/2023, point 18 of the Regulations of the Prosecutor's Office, approved by Order of the Acting Prosecutor General No 33/3 of 03.05.2022,

**WE ORDER:**

1. The Action Plan for Intellectual Property Rights Enforcement in the Republic of Moldova for 2026-2029 (hereinafter referred to as the Action Plan) is approved, according to the annex.

2. The responsible public authorities and institutions shall:

2.1. ensure the implementation, within the limits of their competences, of the actions included in the Action Plan;

2.2. submit information on the implementation of the Action Plan to the State Agency on Intellectual Property (hereinafter referred to as AGEPI), by February 28 of the year following the year under review.

3. AGEPI shall monitor and submit an annual report to the Observatory on Enforcement of Intellectual Property Rights on the implementation of the Action Plan by April 30 of the year following the year of management.

4. Institutional control over the execution of the provisions of this order shall be the responsibility of the heads of the signatory parties.
